Subject: Free Clinics Federal Tort Claims Act (FTCA) Program - Malpractice Liability Coverage – Calendar Year (CY) 2017 Deeming Effective January 01, 2018 through December 31, 2018.

Dear Amin Salahuddin:

The Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA), in accordance with Section 224(o) of the Public Health Service (PHS) Act, 42 U.S.C. § 233(o) (Section 194 of the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (Public Law 104-191), as amended by the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (Public Law 111-148)), deems each volunteer health professional, board member, officer, employee, and individual contractor (collectively referred to as “covered individuals”) who is named on the enclosed list to be an employee of the Public Health Service (PHS) for purposes of Federal Tort Claims Act (FTCA) medical malpractice liability coverage for the period listed above. Please be aware that any additional individuals associated with the sponsoring free clinic who are not named on the enclosed or previously approved list are not deemed to be PHS employees absent HRSA’s approval of a supplemental deeming application on their behalf.

This deeming determination is based on information provided in your free clinic’s sponsoring FTCA deeming application, as required under 42 U.S.C. § 233(o)(5)(C)(i), and in particular with regard to the following statutory prerequisites: (1) implementation of appropriate policies and procedures to reduce the risk of malpractice; (2) implementation of a system whereby professional credentials and privileges, references, claims history, fitness, professional review organization findings and licensure status of health professionals are reviewed and verified; (3) cooperation with the Department of Justice (DOJ) in the defense of claims and actions to prevent claims in the future; and (4) cooperation with DOJ in providing information related to previous malpractice claims history.

To maintain FTCA coverage, the sponsoring free clinic and each covered individual must comply with all applicable statutory requirements, as further detailed in Program Information Notice (PIN) 2011-02. By Section IV(L) of the Calendar Year 2017 deeming application, your free clinic has informed HRSA that currently sponsored free clinic volunteer health professionals have each been provided with a copy of PIN 2011-02 and that any questions regarding FTCA medical malpractice coverage have been addressed. Your free clinic should now also provide copies of this letter and PIN 2011-02 to each free clinic volunteer health professional, board member, officer, employee, and individual contractor named on the enclosed list and deemed pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 233(o) and should reconfirm that each one understands the statutory requirements and limitations on coverage, including but not limited to those detailed in sections III and IV of the Policy Manual.

FTCA coverage is effective for the coverage period listed above, provided that the free clinic maintains its qualified sponsorship status under the PHS Act and that each covered individual named on the enclosed list maintains necessary licensure or certification in accordance with applicable law. In order for a free clinic volunteer health professional, board member, officer, employee, and individual contractor to maintain deemed status, the free clinic must annually submit a FTCA renewal application in accordance with HRSA requirements on behalf of the volunteer. If the free clinic fails to submit a renewal application, FTCA coverage for the sponsored covered individuals will terminate on December 31 of the applicable calendar year.

FTCA coverage is comparable to an “occurrence” policy without a monetary cap. Therefore, any coverage limits that may be mandated by other organizations are met. For example, FTCA coverage would meet the requirements of a \$1.0 million each claim/\$3.0 million aggregate occurrence policy, since FTCA coverage would, as appropriate, provide payment to a plaintiff for any damages awarded as a result of a judgment or settlement, including sums in excess of policy requirements.
